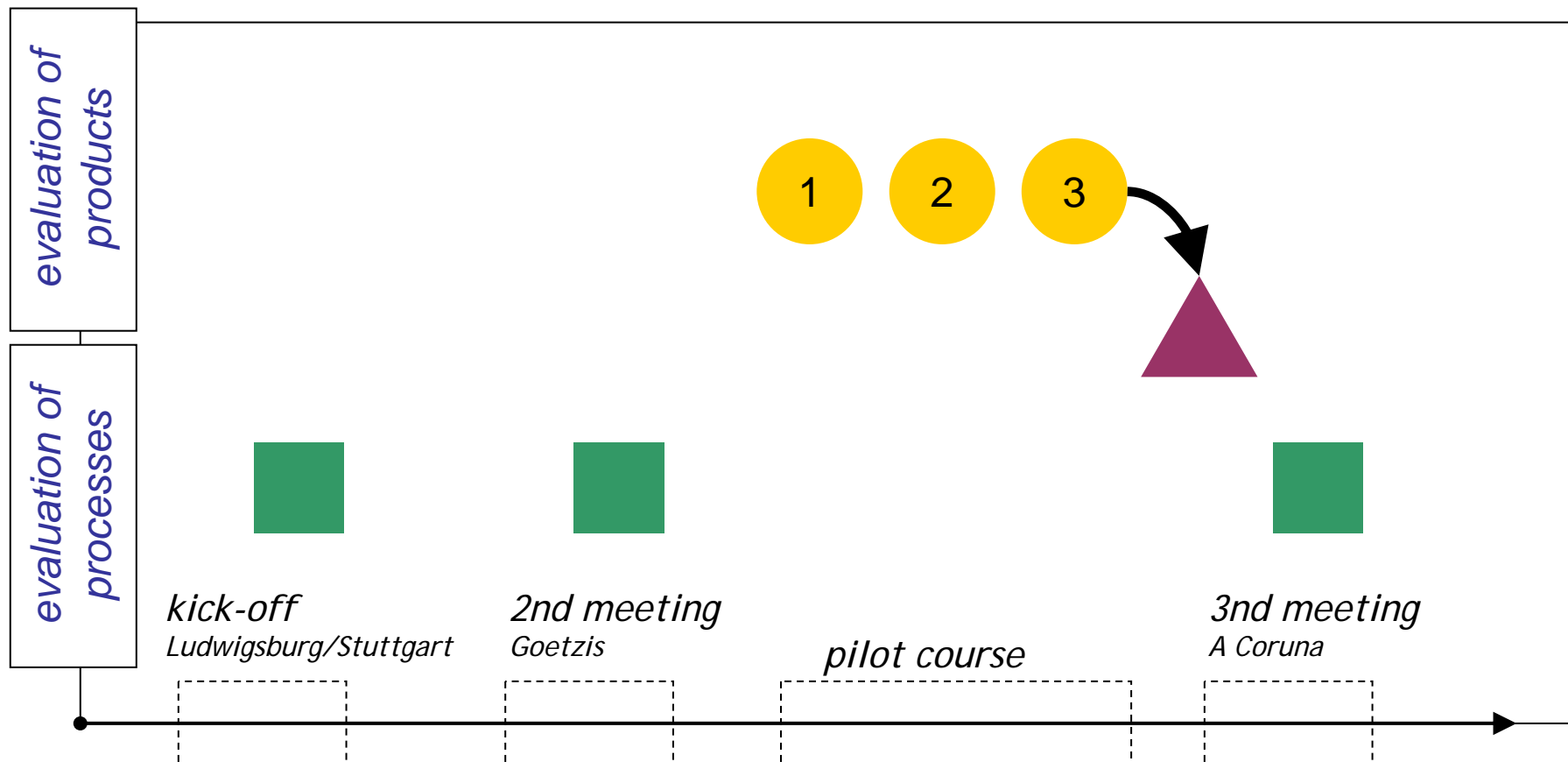

E-tridem.net: timetable first year

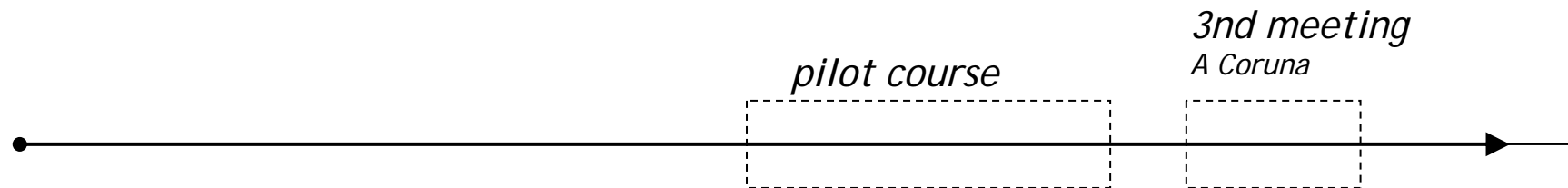

- “highlight intercultural experience” includes both reflecting language/culture of the learning partners and their own
- improving language skills
- improving computer literacy

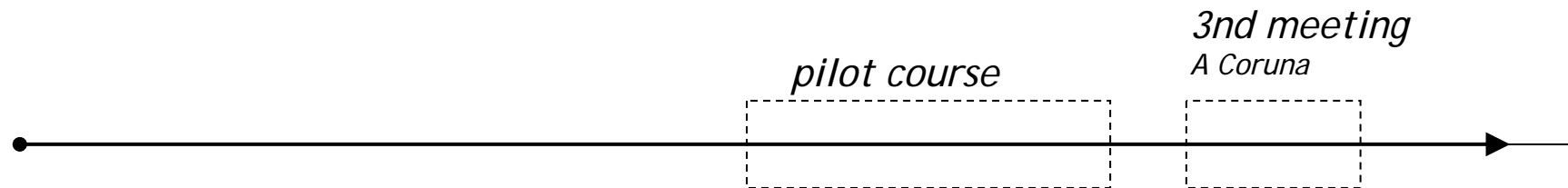

- personal appeal strengthens learner's motivation
- task design:
 - Task volume <-> available time resources
 - explanation what to do (clear, in time, ...)
 - Moderation of communication parts
- focus on communication and collaboration (not to much internet research)

- Simple use is important

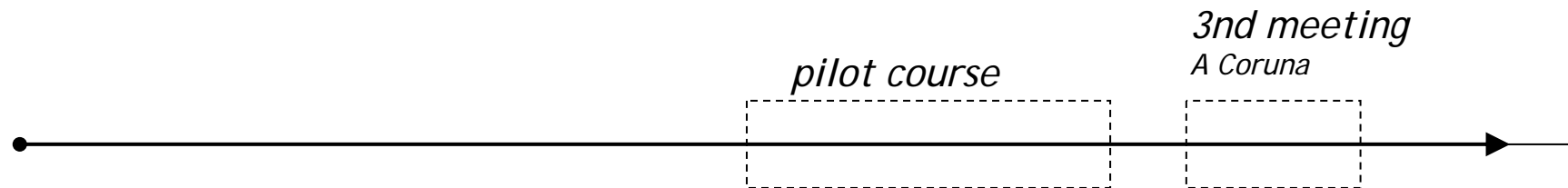

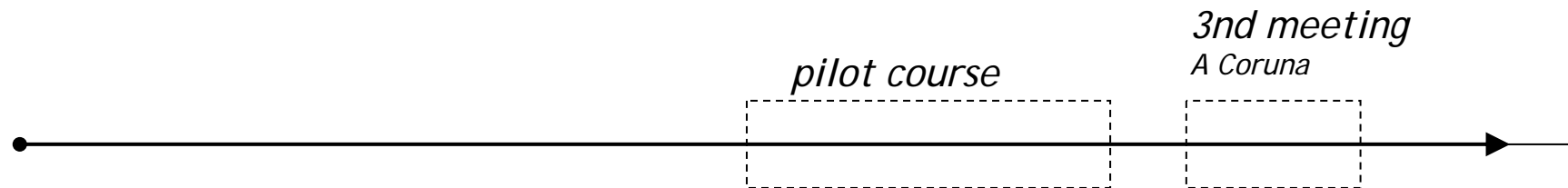

- preconditions for participants:
 - minimum language level
 - basic ICT-skills
 - enough time resources to participate
- guidelines for learners, tutors, guide-on-the-side
- checklists for learners, tutors
- Tasks, themes, umbrella subjects:
personal appeal, one (!) subject, less stereotypes..
